Real time monitoring of observations by Regional WIGOS Centres Luis Nunes, WMO Secretariat

The registration and monitoring of observations exchanged in real time, globally, is a functionality critical to the quality of weather forecasts. In regions where the observations are sparse, the absence of data for prolonged periods introduces significant gaps. WMO has established a set of tools, which implemented sustainably, would enable a n effective detection of missing observations. Regional WIGOS metadata management are designed to work with data providers to facilitate collection, updating and provision of quality control for WIGOS metadata in OSCAR/Surface, while the WIGOS Data Quality Monitoring System (WDQMS) function, in particular evaluation and incident management, by following-up with data providers on availability/quality issues. The presentation will outline the functionality and the benefits of establishing regional WIGOS centre capabilities.
