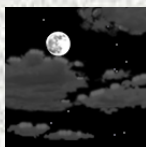
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Weak high pressure over the Ross Island region will bring mostly light winds and fair skies today. A low pressure system in the southeast Ice Shelf will pass well to our east this evening bringing us variably cloudy skies and a few flurries overnight.
