**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

The same low pressure system is still sitting just off shore in the Ross Sea, and the next wave will move through the Ross Island region today. Clouds will once again move in, lowering throughout the day, and winds will once again pick up and remain fairly gusty through the forecast period. Periods of snow and mist will also occur, particularly later tonight.
