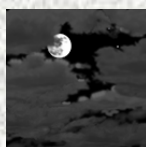
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

High pressure is weakening today with an approaching trough bringing gustier winds today with clouds and periods of light snow overnight. Light winds on the ice shelf have allowed very cold air (-45C) and ice fog to settle over the airfield, with wind chills approaching CON2 values this morning.
