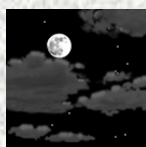
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A broad area of high pressure will bring fair weather Saturday into Sunday. Low pressure developing over the ice shelf Sunday will bring cloudy skies and strong winds late Monday afternoon, continuing through Tuesday. With recent strong winds, and little new snow, visibilities should be less severely reduced in town.

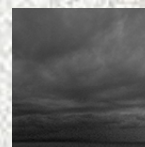
