Another cold and windy day here on Hut Point Peninsula. A bit of cold air has moved off the continent and over us, and a low center is expected to develop in the vicinity today, adding snow to the mix overnight to complete the windy, snowy, cold trifecta. But bring to mind that rosy hint of dawn we saw in the sky above the ridgeline yesterday, and know that while it will still be windy, snowy and cold in the coming weeks (frequently more so, even) we'll have brighter outdoor lighting sometimes, too.
