REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

There's a low pressure system moving northward off the far edge of the ice shelf today. It's 500 miles to our east – close enough that we will experience a slight increase in wind speed as a result. Temperatures here on the rock have settled into the -20 to -30 range – but out on the ice we've seen -40 or lower this week. Add in the slightly higher wind speeds and we've got notably cold wind chills to contend with today, otherwise the weather is fine. Layer up if planning to be out more than a few minutes, and enjoy.

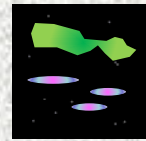
