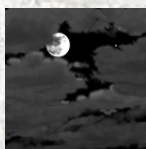

**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Winds die down and temperature falls today as the last of the low centers departs. The night should begin with fair but colder conditions, but a patch of low clouds moving down from the sound (over ample open water, thanks to the recent storm) will likely deliver intermittent snow showers through tomorrow.
