REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

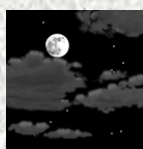
Variable cloudiness, occasional freezing fog and snow flurries, falling temperatures (more so at Scott than McMurdo) and periodic gusty winds (particularly on the road to Scott Base) continue through the weekend. (Sometimes just one line is enough.)
