**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Today will be a fair weather day, with temperatures in the minus-teens and less gusty winds all under mostly clear skies. Tonight that begins to change, as the winds become consistently stronger under the influence of another relatively weak low moving northward across the ice shelf. Its snow delivery is expected tomorrow, when gusts to 40 knots should be frequent and 50 occasional. The result should be familiar to all by now.
