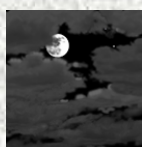
### REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

More cold today and tomorrow – with winds added into the mix here at McMurdo. We've been remarkably fortunate in that regard this week, but it seems our luck has run out. A much more typical (this season, at least) 15-20 gust 25 knots episode is on the way this afternoon and again tomorrow. In that event wind chills will plunge below -50C in town. On the ice the ambient temperature is already that low; at that temperature just four knots of wind drops the wind chill to Con 2 (-59C / -75F). Stay warm!
