REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

This could be the day our luck runs out as far as mild weather is concerned. Winds are picking up as a low to the distant east pushes ever slightly westward, boosting the normal southerly flow to the point that storm-force gusts are expected through much of the day. Still looks mostly dry, though – so visibility should remain reasonably good here on the island outside of any brief periods of fresh snow. Notably warmer temperatures are already in place, and will continue to rise.
