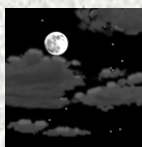
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Wind, snow, and cold: today we only get one. The winds have shifted away east of the island where they belong, the snow has moved off north. As for cold, it's actually only going to be in the minus-teens (C, not F) for much of today (though as noted previously you don't want spend time explaining to people who aren't here that this isn't cold) - but falling. Minus 20-something for most of tomorrow.
