**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY:**

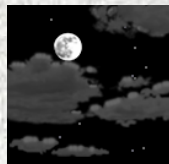
Cloudy skies are forecasted today due to a slow moving low pressure system on the Ross Ice Shelf. Increased wind speeds this afternoon and evening create the potential for blowing and drifting snow. Temperatures are expected to remain relatively warm throughout the forecast period, however, there's always the wind chill to keep in mind.
