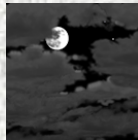
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure is pushing in from the south with light snow with some gusty winds, reducing visibilities in blowing snow. A slightly warmer day is on tap, but quickly cools overnight. Cloud cover eventually starts clearing tomorrow, but it remains cold.

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted
