High pressure, centered over the west-central Ross Ice Shelf this morning, will move north into the western Ross Sea tomorrow. Light NW winds will bring increasing moisture into town from the Ross Sea later today through tomorrow morning, accompanied by periods of cloudy skies. Winds will remain light and mild temperatures will persist.
