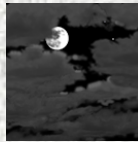
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Expect generally light winds through the overnight before they increase tomorrow morning. Also, a heads up, the future is showing the next big one spinning up for the weekend.
