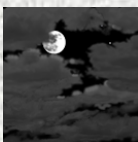
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Stuck between low pressure north and low pressure south, we'll see a variety of weather through this period. There will be periods of snow and blowing snow, light winds and gusty winds, and mostly clear to mostly cloudy skies. The only constant, still cold!

Sky: Mostly Clear to Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 4-6 w/snow & blowing snow, becoming Unrestricted, occasional flurries

Wind (kts): NE 10-15 gusts to 20, decreasing to NW-N 10-15

Max Temp: -23°C / -9°F

Min Wind Chill: -40°C / -40°F

Sky: Partly to Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional flurries

Wind (kts): N-NE 5-10

Min Temp: -30°C / -22°F

Min Wind Chill: -43°C / -45°F

Sky: Partly Cloudy to Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 2-4, occasional 1-3 w/snow & blowing snow

Wind (kts): Light & Variable, becoming N-NE 15-20 gusts to 30

Max Temp: -22°C / -8°F

Min Wind Chill: -47°C / -53°F
