Strong winds to start, with a slow decrease through the day. After a short respite lasting into the early overnight, the winds once again increase, and yet further increasing around noon. The really sad part though, the temperatures will slowly decrease, thus greatly affecting wind chills. All this due to a deep low pressure system that moves onto the Shelf.

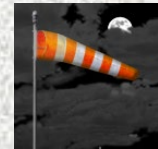

Sky: Mostly Clear to Partly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, w/drifted snow

Wind (kts): E 15-20 gusts to 30, decreasing to NE-E 10-15

Max Temp: -18°C / 0°F

Min Wind Chill: -40°C / -40°F

Sky: Partly to Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, w/drifted snow

Wind (kts): NE-E 5-10, becoming 10-15 gusts to 25

Min Temp: -27°C / -17°F

Min Wind Chill: -41°C / -42°F

Sky: Partly to Mostly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted w/drifted snow, occasional 2-4 w/blowing snow

Wind (kts): E-SE 15-20 gusts to 30, increasing to 20-25 gusts to 40

Max Temp: -22°C / -8°F

Min Wind Chill: -46°C / -51°F
