**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Low pressure moves from west to east across the northern part of the Shelf. Although the day starts with light winds, by lunch time, the winds increase. Clouds move down the Sound. Cold wind chills continue. Compared to the highest temps in the US, we range 130°-140° F colder. Yikes! But it does warm slightly.
