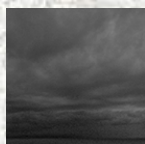

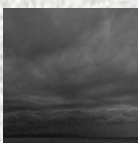
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

A low pressure system is moving up from the south bringing in cloudy skies and occasional light snow, with more consistent snow fall tomorrow. Temperatures warm rapidly this morning and remain steady. Winds pick up a bit tomorrow, probably dropping visibilities in blowing snow.
