REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

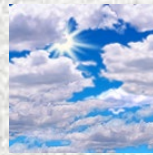
A chance of overnight-early morning fog tonight (with a sprinkling of snow flurries, perhaps) is about the only thing marring an otherwise fair weather forecast for the next two days, as generally stable conditions prevail in the absence of large scale weather systems.

Visibility (SM): Periods of 2-3 w/ mist and snow flurries in the early a.m. becoming unrestricted
