**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

With no major migratory systems upstream from Ross Island, glacial flow is expected to continue to push along the Trans Antarctic mountains to the station. This pattern will persist throughout the period with little in the way of cloud cover and temperatures slightly below seasonal norms.
