MCMURDO WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

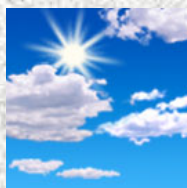

A dual low pressure setup develops to the east of station, preparing hit station with elevated winds from the south. As the smaller low extends southwards, it will send winds streaming towards McMurdo, causing rather unpleasant wind bursts and fuzzy horizons throughout the day.

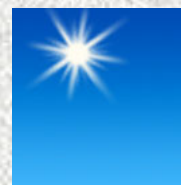
