

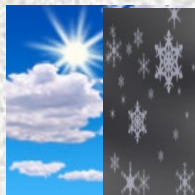

REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure is retreating from Ross Island allowing a couple of small circulations to skirt the region. Clouds will increase this morning with periods of light snow into the evening. Relatively mild temperatures and typical winds will prevail over town today, however the warming has not reached the Ice Shelf just yet.

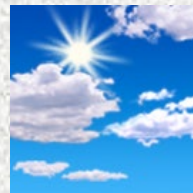
