## REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The low has left the vicinity, with much improved weather today under relatively high pressure. Cold & gusty (but dry!) glacial outflow makes its way into the area this evening, bringing a drop in temperature and wind chill overnight. Tomorrow a minor low pressure wave makes its way northward along the western ice shelf resulting in increasing cloudiness through the day and eventually snow just after midnight tomorrow, perhaps a few flurries before.
