REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

High pressure continues with upper-level westerly winds from Victoria Land giving us clear skies, colder temps, light winds, and excellent views of auroras, stars, and planets as continuous winter night-time fast approaches. The last official sunset is this Friday, 24 April, at 1:31pm local time to the true north (unfortunately the horizon is blocked by terrain to that direction from town). The extended outlook shows favorable weather conditions through Thursday.
