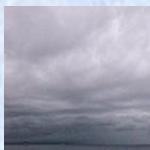
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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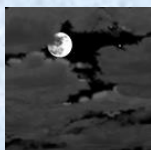
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

An approaching ridge from the west will usher the low pressure system in the Weddell Sea further south away from the peninsula resulting in moderate winds, improving sky conditions later today into the night with a look at some sunshine tomorrow.
