**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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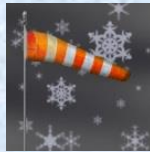
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

We will get one more good weather day before our ridge gives way to an approaching trough extending from a low pressure system in the Bellingshausen Sea. Increasing winds and periods of snow can be expected this evening, overnight, and into tomorrow with winds decreasing during the day tomorrow.
