PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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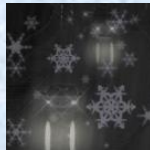
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The strengthening low pressure system in the Bellingshausen Sea will advance towards Alexander Island as troughs from the system will pass through Palmer Station during the period. Expect snow today, a mix of snow and rain overnight as temperatures warm, and mostly rain tomorrow with winds increasing as the system approaches the peninsula.

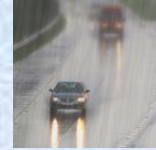
