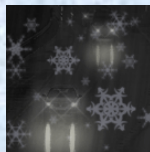
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The strengthening low pressure system to the southwest will bring increased winds and precipitation as it approaches the station. A mixture of rain and snow is expected today as the temperature surpasses zero degrees Celsius. As the low system takes off to the east tomorrow evening, the winds and precipitation will decrease.

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 2-4 in rain, snow and mist

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 1-3 in rain, snow and mist

Wind (kts): NW 15-25 gusting 30

Min Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasionally 2-4 in snow and mist

Wind (kts): W-NW 10-20 gusting 30, becoming SW 5-10

Max Temp: -1°C / 30°F
