PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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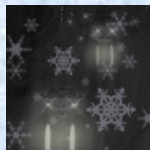
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Another potent low pressure system in the southern Bellingshausen Sea causing heavy snow/rain mix and steadily increasing winds today and into the evening hours. Late tomorrow morning, conditions will improve significantly as the center of low pressure moves Northeast of the Ronne Ice Shelf.

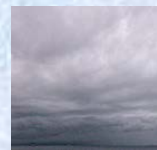

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 1 - 3 in snow

Wind (kts): N 5-10 becoming NW-N 20 Gusting 30

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Visibility (SM): ¼- 1 in snow/rain mix becoming 1-3 in snow and mist

Wind (kts): NW 15-25

Min Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F

Visibility (SM): 4-6 in snow becoming unrestricted

Wind (kts): SW-W 10-20

Max Temp: -2°C / 28°F
