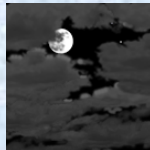
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Manageable weather conditions today and overnight transition to unsettled weather tomorrow as a vertically stacked and cut off low pressure system settles in northwest of Eltanin Bay. Tomorrow's weather could see gusts to forty knots and visibilities severely hindered by snow.
