PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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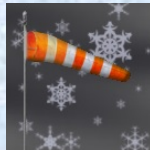
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure center approaches the peninsula coast south of Anvers Island today, then moves northward – but fortunately weakens as it passes by. Expect windy and snowy periods today, then fair conditions tomorrow as a high pressure ridge builds in behind the low.

Sky: Partly Cloudy becoming Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 3-5 in mixed precipitation, snow

Wind (kts): NE 15-20 becoming NE 25-35 gusting 45

Max Temp: 2°C / 36°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Sky: Cloudy becoming Partly Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 3-5 in snow becoming unrestricted

Wind (kts): N 20-30 gusting 40 becoming N 10-15

Min Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -10°C / 14°F

Sky: Partly Cloudy occasionally Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, occasional snow flurries

Wind (kts): Variable 5-10

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F
