PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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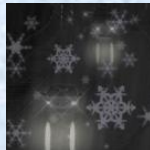
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A low pressure system moving east off of the Bellingshausen Sea will move across the peninsula today. Tonight, the system slows as it passes east of the Boyd Strait giving us colder air aloft and greater snow chances. Tomorrow, the system moves East of Robertson Island giving us cooler Southwestern flow and a chance of snow.

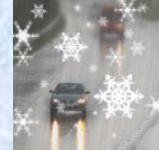
