**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Low pressure center to the southwest continues to bring cloudy skies and an intermittent snow/rain mix to Palmer Station today and tonight. The death of the low, as it moves over the peninsula, will allow for a break in the overcast and minimal precipitation until the next low system approaches.
