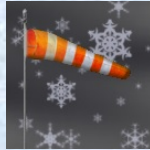
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A quasi-stationary low pressure center to the west will maintain northerly flow over the area today. A trough circulating around that low will bring strong winds and heavier precipitation tonight. Expect winds and precipitation to decrease as the low weakens tomorrow.
