PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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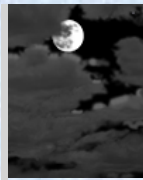
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The most significant portion of this low will move from the South American coast to the northern portion of the Antarctic Peninsula today and tonight., causing a bit of an increase in winds later today and tonight.
