A frontal boundary to crash the Palmer area this evening off low pressure crossing the northern Antarctic Peninsula. Expect high wind peaking over the midnight hours, and swinging to the northwest tomorrow with lowered visibility in snow and fog as the main low drops into the Weddell Sea...
