**PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION**

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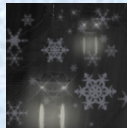
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Little change in the overall pattern. Low pressure remains over the western Bellingshausen Sea, however the jet has pushed slightly south of the previous forecast, delaying the onset of predominant snow. Palmer Station will remain in unsettled weather for the next 36-48 hours. Waves of strong gusty winds and occasionally heavy precipitation and fog will be interspersed with brief lulls throughout the period.

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 3 – 5 in rain and mist. Occasionally Unrestricted

**Wind (kts):** Variable 7-12 early becoming W-NW 20-30, with occasional gusts to 40 midday

**Max Temp:** 4°C / 37°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -10°C / 14°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 3-5 in rain and mist, reduced ½ -2 in snow, mixed with rain, and fog overnight

**Wind (kts):** ) : N 25-30, gusting 35

**Min Temp:** -2°C / 28°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -15°C / 5°F

**Sky:** Cloudy

**Visibility (SM):** 2 – 4 in rain mixed with snow. Occasionally <½ -2 in snow and mist.

**Wind (kts):** NW 15-20, gusting 30, becoming W-NW 25-35, with occasional gusts to 45 midday

**Max Temp:** 1°C / 34°F

**Min Wind Chill:** -16°C / 3°F
