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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Little change in the overall pattern. Low pressure remains over the western Bellingshausen Sea, however the jet has pushed slightly south of the previous forecast, delaying the onset of predominant snow. Palmer Station will remain in unsettled weather for the next 36-48 hours. Waves of strong gusty winds and occasionally heavy precipitation and fog will be interspersed with brief lulls throughout the period.
