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REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure has moved into the NW Weddell Sea with a trough trailing over the northern peninsula. Decreasing winds and precipitation will follow its passage. Skies will remain mostly cloud with occasional partly cloudy skies late Sunday into Monday morning. Another trough will approach Monday with winds and periods of snow returning Monday afternoon.

Sky: Cloudy, becoming Mostly cloudy late

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted , with brief periods of light snow and Fog

Wind (kts):): Variable 7-12 early morning

Min Temp: -2°C / 28°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F

Sky: Mostly Cloudy to Cloudy

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted. Becoming 3-5 in snow, occasionally 1-2 in snow and fog afternoon

Wind (kts): Variable 7-12. Becoming NNW 16-22 gusting 30 midday

Max Temp: 0°C / 32°F

Min Wind Chill: -7°C / 19°F
