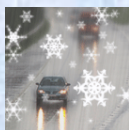
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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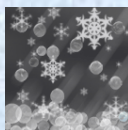
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A high pressure ridge is passing over the northern peninsula in advance of the next front approaching from the southwest. Mostly cloudy skies and relatively calm winds will swing NW Monday afternoon with snow resuming. Winds and precipitation will diminish again overnight into Tuesday afternoon. Winds and rain increase yet again Tuesday evening associated with the remnants of a low pressure system approaching from the west Chilean coast
