PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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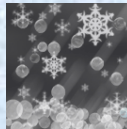
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

The interaction of low pressure in the western Bellingshausen Sea and high pressure ridging into the Drake Passage, is producing a steady W-NW flow over the northern Palmer Peninsula. Multiple troughs will transit the region, producing bands of snow today with mixed precip and rain Wednesday.
