Weak ridging from the SE Pacific will help keep winds light into midday Friday. A persistently moist westerly flow aloft will keep skies cloudy with periods of rain, snow and fog throughout the forecast period.

A low pressure system along the Eights Coast will push into the southern peninsula Friday, with an associated front bringing increasing rain Friday afternoon, with winds increasing from the west after passage Friday evening.
