PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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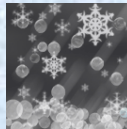
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Low pressure systems are moving into the northern Bellingshausen Sea and stalling there. Weak ridging will bring a mostly dry day with even some blue skies from Saturday late morning into the late evening. Sadly, the respite will be short. Clouds, northerly winds and snow, switching to mixed precipitation, will return early Sunday morning ahead of the next frontal passage.

Sky: Mostly Cloudy becoming Partly Cloudy late morning

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted. Occasional light snow early

Wind (kts): Variable 5-10

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -6°C / 21°F

Sky: Partly Cloudy becoming Cloudy by midnight

Visibility (SM): Unrestricted, becoming 5-7 in Snow after midnight. Occasionally 2-4 in mixed precipitation by morning

Wind (kts): Variable 5-10, becoming NNE 18-25 gusting 30, by morning

Min Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Min Wind Chill: -13°C / 9°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 in rain mixed with snow. Becoming Unrestricted by evening

Wind (kts): NNW 15-20, gusting 25. Becoming W 10-15 gusting 20l by evening.

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Min Wind Chill: -8°C / 18°F
