PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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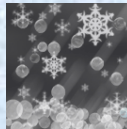
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

A frontal boundary extends from low pressure in the NW Bellingshausen Sea across the Palmer Peninsula. A new low pressure system will form along the boundary and cross the peninsula Sunday producing strong Northerly winds and snow Sunday. Precipitation and winds will decrease Sunday night with only brief periods of light snow Monday

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 1-3 snow, occasionally mixed with rain.

Wind (kts): NNW 20-27, gusting 40. Becoming Variable 5-10 afternoon

Max Temp: 1°C / 34°F

Sky: Cloudy

Visibility (SM): 2-4 in mixed precipitation, occasionally Unrestricted overnight

Wind (kts):) : NE 8-15

Min Temp: -3°C / 27°F

Visibility (SM): 2-4 in Snow ending early. Becoming Unrestricted midday

Wind (kts): NE 10-15. Becoming SE 15-20 gusting 27 midday
