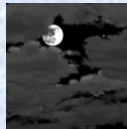
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Enjoy one more fine day, and batten down the hatches before bedtime! The high pressure over the SW Bellingshausen Sea bringing fair weather today, will move east tonight. A strong low pressure system will rapidly approach from the western Chilean coast overnight, and cross the peninsula just north of the station Wednesday night. Expect conditions to deteriorate rapidly overnight with gale to storm force winds and snow by Wednesday morning
