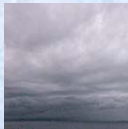

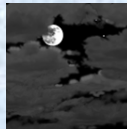
**REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY**

Low pressure is rapidly moving east with high pressure ridging into the eastern Bellingshausen Sea. Dry weather, with light easterly winds and higher clouds will prevail for the next 36-48 hours. The next low pressure system will move into the southern Bellingshausen Sea late Friday night with the station starting to see the effects early Saturday morning
