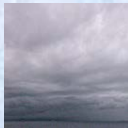
PALMER STATION WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

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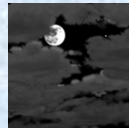
REGIONAL WEATHER SUMMARY

Weak high pressure is ridging into the eastern Bellingshausen Sea bringing light winds with a few snow showers today. Clouds will lift Friday night into Saturday morning with the next low pressure system moving into the southern Bellingshausen Sea Saturday morning. Winds and cloud will increase late Saturday afternoon with snow beginning late evening.
